Introduction: The National Atmospheric Emissions Inventory regulations were published in April 2015 under GN R282.

These regulations serve to regulate the reporting of data and information from identified point, non-point and mobile sources of atmospheric emissions to the internet-based National Atmospheric Emissions Inventory System for the compilation of Atmospheric Emission Inventories. These identified sources include all mines or operations with an Atmospheric Emissions Licence (AEL) and requires that these operations register and submit information to the South African Air Quality Information System (SAAQIS) every year by the 31st of March.
