We supply, attached hereto a list of the meetings we are planning.

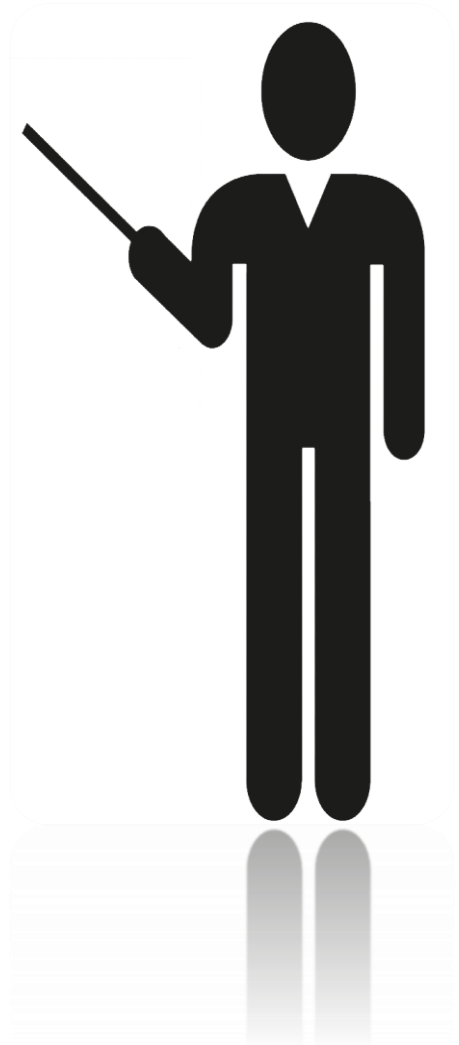
### Some interesting issues:
