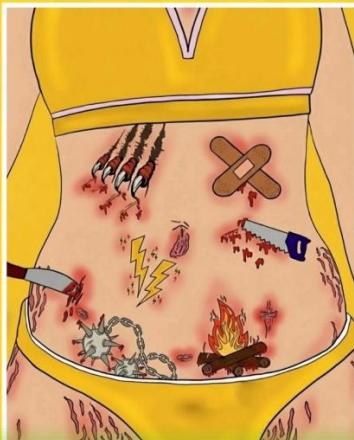
Endometriosis



Endometriosis is a chronic, often painful disease where tissue similar to the lining of the uterus grows outside it, typically in the pelvis. It causes inflammation, scar tissue (adhesions), and symptoms like severe menstrual pain, chronic pelvic pain, and infertility. There is no cure, but treatments include pain medication, hormonal therapies, and surgery

The exact cause is unknown, but it may involve retrograde menstruation (tissue flowing backward), immune system dysfunction, or genetic factors

Treatment focuses on managing pain and reducing the impact on fertility, including pain relief (NSAIDs), hormonal contraception, and surgical removal of lesions
